With only four months left in the school year, we are certainly into the home stretch! I want to thank everyone for helping us to successfully navigate an unprecedented school year. In spite of the challenges, we are having a really amazing year!

We are excited to announce that **Kindergarten Registration is OPEN**. Children who turn five


(5) on or before **December 31, 2021** are eligible to enter kindergarten for the 2021 – 22 school year. Westmount School plans to offer two kindergarten programs:

- **Program 1 Full Time Kindergarten**: This program runs all day, every school day.
- Program 2 Regular Kindergarten: This program runs full days Tuesday/Thursday & some Fridays.

A reminder of our weather policy: If the wind chill drops below -25C, we do not send students outside for recess. When the wind chill is between -20C and -25C, we send students outside for a short amount of time to get some fresh air and burn off energy. Anything warmer than -20C with the wind chill and our students will go outside for regular recess. We encourage our students to come ready for the range of weather that is possible throughout the winter months. Check out the end of this newsletter for a great infographic!


#### Student Pick-Up and Drop Off
